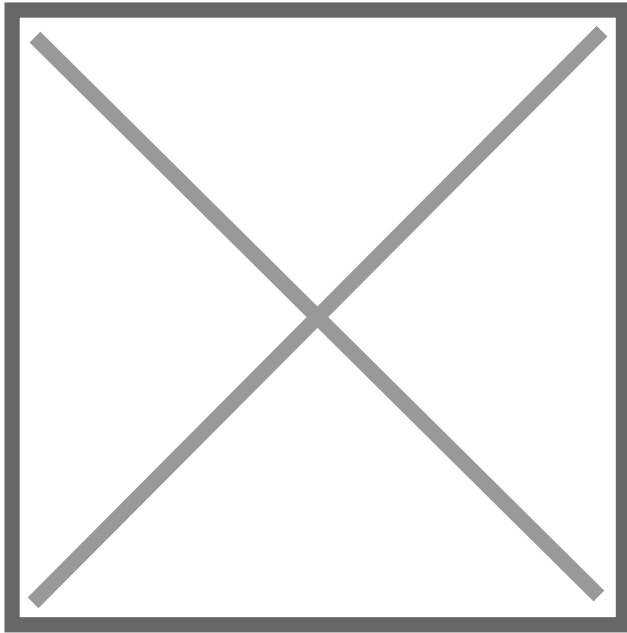

Being able to run powerful language models locally, with the flexibility to fine-tune and experiment in a more personalized and secure environment, opens up so many possibilities.

Steps to run [DeepSeek AI](#) locally with [Ollama](#) on Docker:

```
# Install Ollama
docker run -d -v ollama:/root/.ollama -p 11434:11434 --name ollama ollama/ollama
# Pull the DeepSeek-R1 model
docker exec -it ollama ollama run deepseek-r1:7b
# Start chatting with DeepSeek-R1 - Web UI
docker run -d -p 3000:8080 --add-host=host.docker.internal:host-gateway -v open-webui:/app/backe
```

Open <http://localhost:3000> in your browser, and you are done!
